- 1. Bids in sealed cover are invited for Supply of fresh Onion at Sainik School Purulia.

- 3. This RFP is divided into five Parts as follows:
- a. Part I Contains General Information and Instructions for the Bidders about the RFP such as the time, place of submission and opening of tenders, Validity period of tenders, etc.
- b. Part II Contains essential details of the items/services required, such as the Schedule of Requirements (SOR), Technical Specifications, Delivery Period, Mode of Delivery and Consignee details.
- c. Part III Contains Standard Conditions of RFP, which will form part of the Contract with the successful Bidder.
- d. Part IV Contains Special Conditions applicable to this RFP and which will also form part of the contract with the successful Bidder.
- e. Part V Contains Evaluation Criteria and Format for Price Bids.
- 4. This RFP is being issued with no financial commitment and the Buyer reserves the right to change or vary any part thereof at any stage. Buyer also reserves the right to withdraw the RFP, should it become necessary at any stage.

Part I – General information

1. Last date and time for depositing the Bids:

21 Mar 2023 at 0900 hrs

The sealed Bids should be deposited/reach by the due date and time. The responsibility to ensure this lies with the Bidder.

2. Manner of depositing the Bids:

Bids are to be deposited in State Government e-procurement portal (wbtenders.gov.in) only.

3. Time and date for opening of Bid:

0900 hrs on 23 Mar 2023

(If due to any exigency, the due date for opening of the Bids is declared a closed holiday, the Bids will be opened on the next working day at the same time or on any other day/time, as intimated by the Buyer).

4. Place of opening of the Bids:

The Bidders may depute their representatives, duly authorised in writing, to attend the opening of Bids on the due date and time. Rates and important commercial/technical clauses quoted by all Bidders will be read out in the presence of the representatives of all the Bidders. This event will not be postponed due to non-presence of your representative.

Only the Technical Bid will be opened on the time and date mentioned above. Commercial Bids of only those firms will be opened, whose Technical Bids are found compliant/ suitable after Technical Evaluation is done by the Buyer.

6. **Forwarding of Bids** – Bids should be forwarded by Bidders under their original memo / letter pad inter alia furnishing details like GST number, Bank address with EFT Account if applicable, etc and complete postal & e-mail address of their office.

- 7. <u>Clarification regarding contents of the RFP</u>: A prospective bidder who requires clarification regarding the contents of the bidding documents shall notify to the Buyer in writing about the clarifications sought within the date and time specified.
- 8. Modification and Withdrawal of Bids: A bidder may modify or withdraw his bid after submission provided that the written notice of modification or withdrawal is received by the Buyer prior to deadline prescribed for submission of bids. A withdrawal notice may be sent by fax but it should be followed by a signed confirmation copy to be sent by post and such signed confirmation should reach the purchaser not later than the deadline for submission of bids. No bid shall be modified after the deadline for submission of bids. No bid may be withdrawn in the interval between the deadline for submission of bids and expiration of the period of bid validity specified. Withdrawal of a bid during this period will result in Bidder's forfeiture of bid security.
- 9. <u>Clarification regarding contents of the Bids</u>: During evaluation and comparison of bids, the Buyer may, at its discretion, ask the bidder for clarification of his bid. The request for clarification will be given in writing and no change in prices or substance of the bid will be sought, offered or permitted. No post-bid clarification on the initiative of the bidder will be entertained.
- 10. <u>Rejection of Bids</u>: Canvassing by the Bidder in any form, unsolicited letter and post-tender correction may invoke summary rejection with forfeiture of EMD. Conditional tenders will be rejected.
- 11. <u>Unwillingness to quote</u>: Bidders unwilling to quote should ensure that intimation to this effect reaches before the due date and time of opening of the Bid, failing which the defaulting Bidder may be delisted for the given range of items as mentioned in this RFP.
- 12. <u>Validity of Bids</u>: The Bids should remain valid for 120 days from the date of opening of tender.
- 13. <u>Earnest Money Deposit</u> Bidders are required to submit online Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) for amount as indicated below against each items along with their bids:

- (a) The non negotiable amount of Earnest Money payable is Rs.9,399.00 (Rupees Nine Thousand Three Hundred Ninety Nine only).
- (b) EMD of the unsuccessful bidders will be returned to them at the earliest upon finalisation of the contract. The bid security of the successful bidders would be returned, without any interest whatsoever, after the receipt of the Performance Security from them as called for in the contract. EMD is not required to be submitted by those bidders who are registered with the Central Purchase

Organisation (e.g. DGS&D), National Small Industries Corporation (NSIC) or any Department of MoD or MoD itself.

- (c) The EMD will be forfeited if the bidder withdraws or amends, impairs or derogates from the tender in any respect within the validity period of their tender.
- (d) Every pages of the RFP is to be stamped and signed by the contractor as acceptance.
- (e) This form is to be downloaded only from State Government e-procurement portal and an amount of Rs.500/- will have to be deposited through NEFT or Online Banking as the tender fee by the successful tenderer.
- (f) GST/any other taxes as per Government policy in vogue.
- (g) **Technical Compliance Statement** is to be filled and signed by the bidder.
- (h) The quantity mentioned in the BOQ is approximate as per the previous year consumption. The actual quantity in Supply Order will differ as per the requirement.
- (j) The time for seeking clarification or checking the samples from the school for the tenderer is from 1000 hrs to 1300 hrs on working days from 28 Feb 2023 to 14 Mar 2023.

PART II - ESSENTIAL DETAILS OF ITEMS/SERVICES REQUIRED

1. **Schedule of Requirements** – List of items / services required is as follows:

Quality

- 1. An appropriate variety as per season shall be approved and accepted for supply. The colour of onion shall be characteristic of its variety. The onion shall be mature, reasonably firm viz not tangibly soft or spongy. May have developed more than one distinct bulb joined only at base. Shapes like flattened globe, globe, high globe, spindle are normal shapes for onion. Onion bulbs shall be dry, well formed and give a rustling noise when handled. They shall be well cured with tough clinging skins and closed necks. Tops when present shall not exceed 2 cm in length and such onions shall not constitute more than 20% by weight of supply. Damaged onions are the onion bulbs, the appearance or the edible or marketing quality of which is materially affected by splitting, dry sunscald, sunburn, staining, sprouting, seed steams or mechanical injuries. Onion with these defects shall be rejected. Various types of damages of onions are indicated as under and onion fresh shall be free from all such defects:-
 - (a) **Splitting**. A split onion having more than one distinct bulb shall be considered as damaged when not completely covered by an outer scale and not well cured.
 - (b) <u>Dry Sunscald</u>. Softening of the tissues of not well cured onions due to exposure to the sun shall be considered as damage by sunscald. If dry and well cured, an onion shall be considered as damaged by sunscald when the injury is more than alight and is readily apparent without peeling it, except when affected area is dry and so inconspicuous that the appearance of onion is not materially injured.
 - (c) <u>Sunburn</u>. Is the discolouration of onions due to exposure to the sun where there is no injury to the tissue. Individual onions shall be considered damaged when this burn exceeds 25% of the total area.
 - (d) **Sprouting**. Onions are those which have visible sprouts.
 - (e) <u>Rooting.</u> Onion exhibiting development of fresh roots shall be considered as damaged.
 - (f) <u>Staining</u>. Onions showing discolouration caused by weathering or other causes seriously affecting the appearance and its natural smell shall be considered as damaged. Onions shall be free from black powdery material on the outer scales or in between the outer and first scale, also from small dark green to black dots that appear on the outer scales in the form of concentric rings or blotches.
 - (g) Onion shall be free from soft fleshy scales, if pressure on the bulb forces, a watery, foul smelling liquid, through the neck or on such pressure

some of the scales slip off. And also grassy, water soaked, Pale-yellowish to light brown or yellow tissue often slimy with vinegar odour and soft spongy scales. They shall be totally free from signs of sweating or moisture condensation, dirt, dust filth or any other material not component of onion bulbs.

- (h) <u>Size</u>. Onion supplies shall be of uniform and fairly well graded for size and the smallest size of onion shall not pass through a circular sieve having aperture 5 Cm x 5 Cm.
- (j) <u>Taste and flavour</u>. The onion shall have the characteristic pungent taste and flavour of onion. The bulbs shall be free from any off taste, smell or odour.

Inspection

- 2. The onion supplies shall be inspected for the prescribed quality and will be approved by the supply officer after his careful inspection and having found supplies conforming to this specification. The onion shall be supplied in suitable clean, dry containers designed to protect the onions from damages deterioration, sweating, decay and contamination of any kind. These containers shall be washed well, disinfected and dried before packing the supplies.
 - (a) The item shall be of good average size, sound, and whole some and free from insect, infestation or damage and fit for human consumption in all respect.
 - (b) The varieties to be supplied and the proportion of such varieties shall be at the discretion of the Purchasing Officer in consultation with Local Medical Authority.
 - (c) All articles must be of fresh and edible, sound and unrotten.
 - (d) The item shall be of seasons and freshly gathered sound crisp and free from blights, discolouration and fungi.
 - (e) The item shall of good average size for their class and not coarse, stringy or old.
 - (f) All vegetables shall be free of stalks, stump and extraneous leaves.
 - (g) The items should be delivered in the school within one day of placement of demand preferably by 0900 hrs. In emergency, it can be sought by the school within any time as specified by the school.
- 2. <u>Technical Details</u>: The bids must be accompanied by the following: -
 - (a) Certificate of GST Registration
 - (b) Copy of PAN
 - (c) Copy of latest IT return acknowledgement for last two years.
 - (d) Scan copy of signed RFP.
 - (e) Bank Account details
 - (f) Trade Licence/ Company Registration Certificate.
 - (g) Copy of Balance Sheet of two financial years.

- (h) Company Credentials/ Experience of similar nature of work.
- (j) Balance Sheet of last two financial years.
- (k) Any other details, as considered necessary.
- 3. <u>Two Bid System</u> Bidders are required to furnish clause by clause compliance of specifications bringing out clearly the deviations from specification, if any. The Bidders are advised to submit the compliance statement.

4. Completion Period -

Contract will be valid from 01 May 2023 to 30 Apr 2024. Please note that Contract can be cancelled unilaterally by the Buyer in case items are not received within the contracted delivery period. Extension of contracted delivery period will be at the sole discretion of the Buyer, with applicability of LD clause.

- 5. <u>Terms for Delivery and Transportation</u> Delivery and Transportation of items will be the sole responsibility of the bidder under his/her own cost.

PART III – STANDARD CONDITIONS OF RFP

The Bidder is required to give confirmation of their acceptance of the Standard Conditions of the Request for Proposal mentioned below which will automatically be considered as part of the Contract concluded with the successful Bidder (i.e. Seller in the Contract) as selected by the Buyer. Failure to do so may result in rejection of the Bid submitted by the Bidder

- 1. <u>Law</u>: The Contract shall be considered and made in accordance with the laws of the Republic of India. The contract shall be governed by and interpreted in accordance with the laws of the Republic of India.
- 2. <u>Effective Date of the Contract</u>: The contract shall come into effect on the date of signatures of both the parties on the contract (Effective Date) and shall remain valid until the completion of the obligations of the parties under the contract. The deliveries and supplies and performance of the services shall commence from the effective date of the contract.
- 3. <u>Arbitration</u>: All disputes or differences arising out of or in connection with the Contract shall be settled by bilateral discussions. Any dispute, disagreement or question arising out of or relating to the Contract or relating to construction or performance, which cannot be settled amicably, may be resolved through arbitration. The standard clause of arbitration is as per Forms DPM-7, DPM-8 and DPM-9 (Available in MoD website and can be provided on request).
- 4. **Penalty for use of Undue influence**: The Seller undertakes that he has not given, offered or promised to give, directly or indirectly, any gift, consideration, reward, commission, fees, brokerage or inducement to any person in service of the Buyer or otherwise in procuring the Contracts or forbearing to do or for having done or forborne to do any act in relation to the obtaining or execution of the present Contract or any other Contract with the Government of India for showing or forbearing to show favour or disfavour to any person in relation to the present Contract or any other Contract with the Government of India. Any breach of the aforesaid undertaking by the Seller or any one employed by him or acting on his behalf (whether with or without the knowledge of the Seller) or the commission of any offers by the Seller or anyone employed by him or acting on his behalf, as defined in Chapter IX of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 or the Prevention of Corruption Act, or any other Act enacted for the prevention of corruption shall entitle the Buyer to cancel the contract and all or any other contracts with the Seller and recover from the Seller the amount of any loss arising from such cancellation. A decision of the Buyer or his nominee to the effect that a breach of the undertaking had been committed shall be final and binding on the Seller. Giving or offering of any gift, bribe or inducement or any attempt at any such act on behalf of the Seller towards any officer/employee of the Buyer or to any other person in a position to influence any officer/employee of the Buyer for showing any favour in relation to this or any other contract, shall render the Seller to such liability/ penalty as the Buyer may deem proper, including but not limited to termination of the contract, imposition of penal damages, forfeiture of the Bank Guarantee and refund of the amounts paid by the Buyer.
- 5. Agents / Agency Commission: The Seller confirms and declares to the Buyer that the Seller is the original manufacturer of the stores/provider of the services referred to in this Contract and has not engaged any individual or firm, whether Indian or foreign whatsoever, to intercede, facilitate or in any way to recommend to the Government of India or any of its functionaries, whether officially or unofficially, to the award of the contract to the Seller; nor has any amount been paid, promised or intended to be paid to any such individual or firm in respect

of any such intercession, facilitation or recommendation. The Seller agrees that if it is established at any time to the satisfaction of the Buyer that the present declaration is in any way incorrect or if at a later stage it is discovered by the Buyer that the Seller has engaged any such individual/firm, and paid or intended to pay any amount, gift, reward, fees, commission or consideration to such person, party, firm or institution, whether before or after the signing of this contract, the Seller will be liable to refund that amount to the Buyer. The Seller will also be debarred from entering into any supply Contract with the Government of India for a minimum period of five years. The Buyer will also have a right to consider cancellation of the Contract either wholly or in part, without any entitlement or compensation to the Seller who shall in such an event be liable to refund all payments made by the Buyer in terms of the Contract along with interest at the rate of 2% per annum above LIBOR rate. The Buyer will also have the right to recover any such amount from any contracts concluded earlier with the Government of India.

- 6. Access to Books of Accounts: In case it is found to the satisfaction of the Buyer that the Seller has engaged an Agent or paid commission or influenced any person to obtain the contract as described in clauses relating to Agents/Agency Commission and penalty for use of undue influence, the Seller, on a specific request of the Buyer, shall provide necessary information/ inspection of the relevant financial documents/information.
- 7. **Non-disclosure of Contract documents**: Except with the written consent of the Buyer/ Seller, other party shall not disclose the contract or any provision, specification, plan, design, pattern, sample or information thereof to any third party.
- 8. <u>Liquidated Damages</u>: In the event of the Seller's failure to submit the Bonds, Guarantees and Documents, supply the stores/goods and conduct trials, installation of equipment, training, etc as specified in this contract, the Buyer may, at his discretion, withhold any payment until the completion of the contract. The BUYER may also deduct from the SELLER as agreed, liquidated damages to the sum of 0.5% of the contract price of the delayed/undelivered stores/services mentioned above for every week of delay or part of a week, subject to the maximum value of the Liquidated Damages being not higher than 10% of the value of delayed stores.
- 9. <u>Termination of Contract</u>: The Buyer shall have the right to terminate this Contract in part or in full in any of the following cases:-
- (a) Items are to be delivered within one day of placement of Supply Order. In case of non-delivery of item within the stipulated period, risk purchase will be made for which the excess expenditure, if any, will be deducted from the bill/security deposit of the tenderer. In case, the contractor fails to supply the items thrice and the school is compelled to make the risk purchase, the contract will be terminated and security deposit will be forfeited.
- (b) The Seller is declared bankrupt or becomes insolvent.
- (c) The delivery of material is delayed due to causes of Force Majeure by more than **(02 months)** provided Force Majeure clause is included in contract.
- (d) The Buyer has noticed that the Seller has utilised the services of any Indian/Foreign agent in getting this contract and paid any commission to such individual/company etc.
- (e) As per decision of the Arbitration Tribunal.

- 10. <u>Notices</u>: Any notice required or permitted by the contract shall be written in the English language and may be delivered personally or may be sent by FAX or e-mail, registered pre-paid mail, addressed to the last known address of the party to whom it is sent.
- 11. <u>Transfer and Sub-letting</u>: The Seller has no right to give, bargain, sell, assign or sublet or otherwise dispose of the Contract or any part thereof, as well as to give or to let a third party take benefit or advantage of the present Contract or any part thereof.
- 12. Patents and other Industrial Property Rights: The prices stated in the present Contract shall be deemed to include all amounts payable for the use of patents, copyrights, registered charges, trademarks and payments for any other industrial property rights. The Seller shall indemnify the Buyer against all claims from a third party at any time on account of the infringement of any or all the rights mentioned in the previous paragraphs, whether such claims arise in respect of manufacture or use. The Seller shall be responsible for the completion of the supplies including spares, tools, technical literature and training aggregates irrespective of the fact of infringement of any or all the rights mentioned above.
- 13. <u>Taxes and Duties</u>: All taxes, duties, levies and charges which are to be paid for the delivery of goods, including advance samples, shall be paid by the supplier under the present contract and the rate shall be inclusive all taxes.

14. Risk & Expense clause -

- a. Should the stores or any installment thereof not be delivered within the time or time specified in the contract documents, or if defective delivery is made in respect of the stores or the Buyer shall after granting the Supplier stipulated time to cure the breach of supply, be at liberty, without prejudice to the right to recover liquidated damages as a remedy for breach of contract, to declare the contract as cancelled either wholly or to the extent of such default.
- b. Should the stores or any installment thereof not perform in accordance with the specifications / parameters provided by the SUPPLIER during the check proof tests to be one in the BUYER's country, the BUYER shall be at liberty, without prejudice to any other remedies for breach of contract, to cancel the contract wholly or to the extent of such default.
- c. In case of a material breach that was not remedied within 01 day, the BUYER shall, having given the right of first refusal to the SUPPLIER be at liberty to purchase, manufacture, or procure from any other source as he things fit other stores of the same or similar description to make good:
 - i. Such default.
 - ii. In the event of the contract being wholly determined the balance of the stores remaining to be delivered thereunder.
- d. Any excess of the purchase price, cost of manufacturer, or value of any stores procured from any other supplier as the case may be, over the contract price appropriate to such default or balance shall be recoverable from the SUPPLIER."

- 15. Rs.500/- (Rupees Five Hundred only) towards the cost of the tender form to be submitted online in favour of Principal, Sainik School Purulia (payable at Purulia) along with Bid.
- 16. All the forms are to be downloaded from the State Government e-procurement portal only.
- 17. Each pages of the RFP is to be stamped and signed by the bidder.
- 18. Rate is to be filled up in the Price Bid/BOQ only in the format specified.
- 19. Items are to be delivered within one day of placement of Supply Order. In case of non-delivery of item within the stipulated period, risk purchase will be made for which the excess expenditure, if any, will be deducted from the bill/security deposit of the tenderer.
- 20. In case, the contractor fails to supply the items thrice and the school is compelled to make the risk purchase, the contract will be terminated and security deposit will be forfeited.

PART IV - SPECIAL CONDITIONS OF RFP

The Bidder is required to give confirmation of their acceptance of Special Conditions of the RFP mentioned below which will automatically be considered as part of the Contract concluded with the successful Bidder (i.e. Seller in the Contract) as selected by the Buyer. Failure to do so may result in rejection of Bid submitted by the Bidder

- 1. Performance Bank Guarantee (In Case of Indigenous seller): The Bidder will be required to furnish a Performance Guarantee by way of Bank Guarantee through a public sector bank or a private sector bank authorized to conduct government business (ICICI Bank Ltd, Axis Bank Ltd or HDFC Bank Ltd) for a sum equal to 10% of the contract value within 30 days of signing of this contract. Performance Bank Guarantee will be valid up to 60 days beyond the date of warranty/ completion of Contract.
- 2. <u>Tolerance Clause</u> To take care of any change in the requirement during the period starting from issue of RFP till placement of the contract, Buyer reserves the right to <u>10%</u> plus/minus increase or decrease the quantity of the required goods up to that limit without any change in the terms & conditions and prices quoted by the Seller. While awarding the contract, the quantity ordered can be increased or decreased by the Buyer within this tolerance limit.
- 3. <u>Payment Terms for Indigenous Sellers</u> It will be mandatory for the Bidders to indicate their bank account numbers and other relevant e- payment details. The payment will be made as per the following terms, on production of the requisite documents:
 - (a) Bills are to be produced within 7th of the succeeding month.
 - (b) Month wise payment will be made on production of desired bills.
- 4. Advance Payments: No advance payment(s) will be made.

5. **Paying Authority**:

- a. Indigenous Sellers: (Name and address, contact details). The payment of bills will be made on submission of the following documents as applicable by the Seller to the Paying Authority along with the bill:
- i. Ink-signed copy of contingent bill / Seller's bill.
- ii. Ink-signed copy of Commercial invoice / Seller's bill.
- iii. Copy of Supply Order.
- iv. CRVs in duplicate.

- 1. **Evaluation Criteria** The broad guidelines for evaluation of Bids will be as follows:
- a. Only those Bids will be evaluated which are found to be fulfilling all the eligibility and qualifying requirements of the RFP, both technically and commercially.
- b. The Bids forwarded by the Bidders will be evaluated by the Buyer with reference to the technical characteristics of the equipment/work as mentioned in the RFP. The compliance of Technical Bids would be determined on the basis of the parameters specified in the RFP. The Price Bids of only those Bidders will be accepted whose Technical Bids would clear the technical evaluation.
- c. The Lowest Bid will be decided by E-tendering system upon the **overall lowest price quoted** by the particular Bidder based on the annual consumption of complete schedule as per the Price Format given at BOQ. All taxes and duties (including those for which exemption certificates are issued) quoted by the Bidders will be considered. The ultimate cost to the Buyer would be the deciding factor for ranking of Bids.
- The Bidders are required to spell out the rates of GST and any other tax in unambiguous d. terms; otherwise their offers will be loaded with the maximum rates of duties and taxes for the purpose of comparison of prices. If reimbursement of any tax is intended as extra, over the quoted prices, the Bidder must specifically say so. In the absence of any such stipulation it will be presumed that the prices quoted are firm and final and no claim on account of such duties will be entrained after the opening of tenders. If a Bidder chooses to quote a price inclusive of any duty and does not confirm inclusive of such duty so included is firm and final, he should clearly indicate the rate of such duty and quantum of excise duty included in the price. Failure to do so may result in ignoring of such offers summarily. If a Bidder is exempted from payment of Customs duty / Excise Duty or any other tax upto any value of supplies from them, they should clearly state that no excise duty will be charged by them up to the limit of exemption which they may have. Stipulations like, excise duty or any other tax was presently not applicable but the same will be charged if it becomes leviable later on, will not be accepted unless in such cases it is clearly stated by a Bidder that any tax will not be charged by him even if the same becomes applicable later on. In respect of the Bidders who fail to comply with this requirement, their quoted prices shall be loaded with the quantum of excise duty which is normally applicable on the item in question for the purpose of comparing their prices with other Bidders.
- e. If there is a discrepancy between the unit price and the total price that is obtained by multiplying the unit price and quantity, the unit price will prevail and the total price will be corrected. If there is a discrepancy between words and figures, the amount in words will prevail for calculation of price.
- f. The Lowest Acceptable Bid will be considered further for placement of contract / Supply Order after complete clarification and price negotiations as decided by the Buyer. The Buyer will have the right to award contracts to different Bidders for being lowest in particular items. The Buyer also reserves the right to do Apportionment of Quantity, if it is convinced that Lowest Bidder is not in a position to supply full quantity in stipulated time.
